NOTICE OF PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE

On February 21, 2020, Baltimore Gas and Electric Company (“BGE” or “the Applicant”) filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for authority to make changes to the Five Forks to Maryland/Pennsylvania Border Transmission Line for a Reliability Project (“the Project”).¹ The Project consists of a rebuild of a 1.89-mile existing 115kV dual circuit transmission line segment between BGE’s Five Forks substation in northern Harford County, Maryland and the Maryland/Pennsylvania border, and involves removal of two existing parallel single-circuit steel lattice towers, supported electric transmission lines, and replacing them with one double-circuit weathering steel monopole line.

A pre-hearing conference in the above-entitled matter is hereby set for Tuesday, April 21, 2020, in the Commission's 19th floor hearing room, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland, beginning at 9:00 a.m. At the pre-hearing conference, any preliminary matters will be discussed, including consideration of

any petitions to intervene that have been filed, and a procedural schedule will be established.

Petitions to intervene must be filed with the Commission's Executive Secretary, Andrew S. Johnston, 6 St. Paul Street, 16th Floor, Baltimore, Maryland 21202, by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 17, 2020, and must reference Case No. 9636. Pursuant to the Commission's March 13, 2020 Notice of Waiver and Relaxed Filing Requirements, no paper copies need be submitted if the filing is public in nature and no more than 25 pages long.

The Applicant is directed to cause a display advertisement to be published in a newspaper in general circulation within Harford County at least twice, in successive weeks, prior to April 21, 2020, and shall include the case caption, case number, and the time, date, place, and purpose of the pre-hearing conference.

Additionally, the Applicant is encouraged to use any social media or other communication methods to advise residents/businesses of Harford County of the date, time, location, and purpose of the pre-hearing conference, as well as the date by which petitions to intervene must be submitted.
