Only the originally signed comment is required. No public comments will be accepted through the Public Comment system after Monday, October 21, 2019.

BGE is hereby directed to publish, at least twice prior to each of the hearing dates, notice of the public hearing and the opportunity for public comment by a display advertisement in newspapers of general circulation in each county or municipality within the BGE service territory. In the display advertisement, BGE is directed to publish the case caption and case number in addition to the date, time, place, and purpose of the hearing. Proof of publication shall be filed with the Commission on or before the dates of each hearing. Additionally, BGE shall place on its home page a notice of the hearings, including the purpose of the hearings, in a manner that a customer need not click on a link to determine the date, time, location, and purpose of the hearings. Finally, BGE is directed to utilize email, its routinely used social media platforms, or other means of communication at its disposal to further notify its customers of the hearings, as appropriate.
