

Aggregated Net Metering Addendum

Maryland regulations require the customer to identify to the utility the host account and the order for which additional accounts should be included in the application of the aggregated energy. For billing purposes, any net excess generation from the “host” will be cascaded to the subsequent accounts in the order defined by the customer. The customer is responsible for notifying the utility of any changes to the designated order of accounts. Customers may submit revised copies of this form to notify BGE of changes to the accounts and/or cascade order.
